- •Rural Community in West TN
- Started in July of 2022
- On-site garden/farm at our food bank
- •23 acres under land management
 - Pollinator Barrier-3 acres
 - Contract Famer 12 acres soil amending
 - Growing Food- 4 acres

- Demonstration Garden- 1 acre
- Row-Style Garden 3 acres







- No piece of Agricultural equipment
- Volunteers- nearly 1,100 hours
- Paid summer intern
- 1 Staff person who is 50% out of 6 months

Inter-Faith Food Shuttle Farm



- Leasing 16 acres on peri-urban property
 - ~15-min drive to downtown Raleigh
 - 8-10 acres in production; 2 acres added this Fall
- Highly diversified crop plan (>25 species)
 - Crops grown by volunteers & staff
 - Crop plan co-designed with Culinary & Distribution for cultural relevance, neighbor preference, & CAP
- Regenerative organic practices
 - Crop rotation, cover cropping, composting, low-till
 - o IPM with OMRI-listed pesticides only; no herbicides

Field Operations



- Mechanized for field prep, bedding, & spraying
 - Medium tractor, small tractor, & BCS
- Volunteer-reliant
- Biodegradable plastic mulch aka bedding
- Leaf mulch between rows
- Crops started from seed on-site
- Drip irrigation from rain-fed pond
 - Field and high tunnel crops
- Well irrigation
 - Nursery GH and hydroponics GH


